



International Incoming Wire Instructions

Use these procedures for wires coming from an international bank outside the US

For International Wires sent in USD

To ensure proper routing and delivery of funds, be sure all fields are used when sending international wires. Missing or inaccurate intermediary details can cause posting delays, returned wires or even loss of funds.

For International Wires sent in Foreign Currency

Contact the Wire department for special instructions. We will need to know what country the funds are being sent from, and what currency they are being sent in.

Customers may receive international wires in a foreign currency; however, they will be converted to USD at the market rate and deposited in USD to their United account.
